Pressure Dynamics operates a number of internal policies to ensure that we are conducting business in an ethical and transparent manner.

These include:

- Code of Business Ethics & Conduct Policy: our code makes clear to employees the actions and behaviour expected of them when representing the organisation. The organisation strives to maintain the highest standards of employee conduct and ethical behaviour when operating abroad and managing its supply chain.
- Recruitment Policy: we operate a robust recruitment policy, in order to safeguard against human trafficking or individuals being forced to work against their will.
- Whistleblowing: we encourage all our employees, customers and other interested parties to report any concerns related to the direct activities, or the supply chain of Pressure Dynamics without fear of reprisals.

This includes any circumstances that may give rise to an enhanced risk of Modern Slavery.
